As we spend time in God’s Word, we’ll see how these qualities come from God and can help us build strong friendships, make wise choices, and reflect God’s love to the world around us.

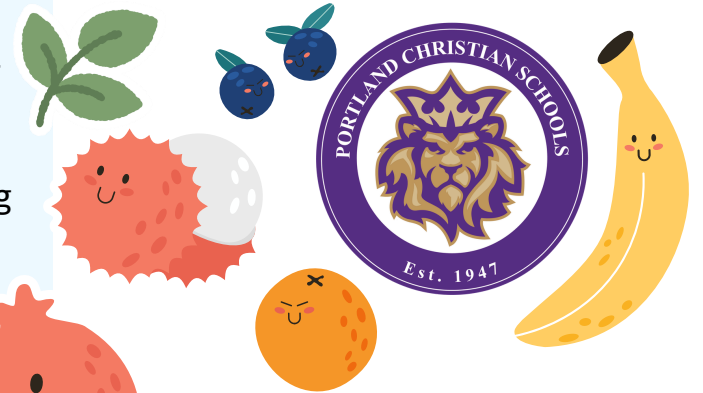
